## Permissions

1. Go to **system** → **Permissions** → **User Roles**.
2. Select the user role you want to grant permission.
3. Go to the tab “Role Resources”.
4. Select **CompactCode** → **Custom Price Per Customer** → **Configuration**.
5. When this is selected, save the role.

Warning: By default, new modules grant access to every user role, even when they are not selected.

To deny permissions, just follow step 1-5. Deselect the mentioned resources and save the role.

## Settings

### Navigate to settings

1. After logging in to the Magento® backend click the CompactCode icon.
2. Click configuration under the “Custom Price Per Customer” title.

### General settings

1. **Module Enable:** enable or disable the Custom Price Per Customer module.

## Subscribers list

### Navigate to list

1. After logging in to the Magento backend, click the CompactCode icon.
2. Click “**View rules**” under Custom Price Per Customer title.

### Add price rules

1. If you want to add price rules, click the “**New Rule**” button on the top of the listing page or go to a customer/product page and navigate to the “**CC | Custom Price Per Customer**” tab. From there, you can click on “**Add price rule**”.
2. Select the customers on which this rule will be applied.
3. Select the products on which this rule will be applied.
4. Determine the price.
  - a. **Price Type:** Is it a fixed amount or percentual?
    - i. Fixed
    - ii. Percent
  - b. **Operation:** What operation should be used for price calculation?
    - i. Increase with (add)
    - ii. Equal to
    - iii. discount (reduce)
  - c. **Price:** The price value.
  - d. **Priority:** How prior should this rule be calculated compared to other prices rules applied to this customer? The higher the priority, the earlier it’s taking into account while calculating.
  - e. **Allow higher than original:** If enabled, the new price will be used even if it’s higher than the original.
  - f. **Discard subsequent rules:** If enabled, ignore other rules with a lower priority than the current rule.
  - g. **Enable rule:** Enable/disable current rule
5. If you are finished, click save.

### Edit a rule

1. If you want to edit price rules, click the “**Edit**” button in the listing. You can do this either on the “**View rules**” page or a customer/product page and navigate to the “**CC | Custom Price Per Customer**” tab.
