



# Product Highlight Attribute User Guide

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## Permissions

1. Go to **system → Permissions → User Roles**.
2. Select the user role you want to grant permission.
3. Go to the tab "Role Resources"
4. Select **CompactCode → Product Attribute Highlight → Configuration**.
5. When this is selected, save the role.

Warning: By default, new modules grant access to every user role, even when they are not selected.

To deny permissions, just follow step 1-4. Deselect the mentioned resources and save the role.

## Settings

### Navigate to settings

1. After logging in to the Magento backend© click the CompactCode icon.
2. Click configuration under the "Product Attribute Highlight" title.

### General settings

1. **Module enable:** Enables the module.
2. **Shown attributes:** this setting will define the number of attributes that are shown.
3. **Add custom CSS:** here you can enter custom CSS. These will only be able on the enabled pages.
4. **Add custom CSS classes:** here, you can enter custom CSS classes. These classes will be added to the <ul> tag of the HTML list

### Page settings

1. **Category Pages:** this setting enables or disables the attribute highlight for the category page.
2. **Wishlist page:** this setting enables or disables the attribute highlight for the wishlist page

### Highlight a product

1. Open the product attributes menu: **Stores → Attributes → Product**.
2. Select the attribute to highlight.
3. Select the tab highlight.

Now you see 2 settings:

1. **Highlight this attribute:** here, you can enable the highlight per attribute.
2. **Highlight priority:** set the priority for that attribute, the higher the count, the higher it will appear in the list.

**Warning: don't forget to enable "used in product listing" in the "storefront properties" tab!**

## Presets

1	General	Module Enable	0	Enables or disables the module.
2		Shown Attributes	3	This setting will define the number of attributes that are shown.
3		Add custom css	<code>ul.highlight-attributes {liststyle-type: none; padding: 0px;}</code>	Here you can enter custom CSS. These will only be available on the enabled products.
4		Add custom css classes		Here you can enter custom classes. These classes will be added to the tag of the HTML list.
5	Page Settings	Category pages	1	Enables or disables the attribute highlight for the category pages.
6		Wishlist page	1	Enables or disables the attribute highlight for the wishlist page.
